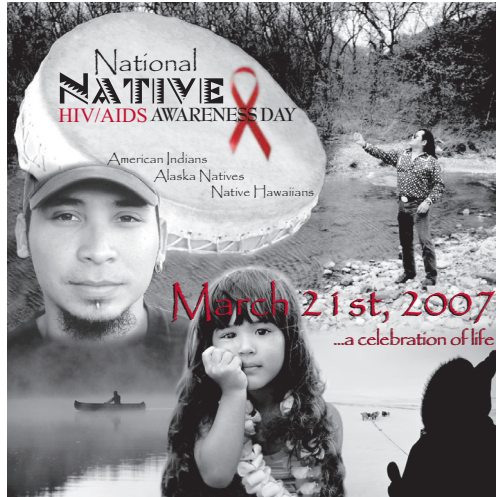


Save the Date
